# Updates from the CCCCCO

---

- ✓ Change from one application per district to one application per college
- ✓ Unit changes – 40 units in upper division
- ✓ ACCJC Requirements – “baccalaureate” in mission statement
- ✓ New rubric used for scoring
  - Point system – 125 total, need 100 to move on in the process
- ✓ Much more competitive going forward

# BC Police Science - Application Update

---

- ✓ Submitted in January 2023 application cycle
- ✓ Great application but the state applied a new rubric
- ✓ Scored 82.5 out of 125 points, need 100 to be considered
- ✓ Intersegmental concerns – CSU's are pushing back

Next steps:

- ✓ Improving application for August re-submittal
